To qualify, the man or woman nominated can presently be working or must have worked for a railroad company from our surrounding area. Community and church service will also be a consideration. (It is acceptable to have more than one person submit a nomination for an individual.)

This year's nominations, along with nominations from 2011, will be reviewed by a selection committee.

The person chosen for the 2012 Railroad Person of the Year Award will receive a plaque at an Honoring Ceremony May 18th at the Durand Union Station. This Honoring Ceremony will be planned by committee members, and all news articles about the person selected as RR Person of the Year will also be the responsibility of the committee.

He/she will ride in the Railroad Days Parade on May 19th, 2012. This year, the Little Obie Engine is not available for the honored person to ride in, but we will come up with suitable transportation for our RR Person of the Year.

At the conclusion of the parade, there will be a reception in the Ballroom at Durand Union Station for family and friends of the honoree. Durand Union Station will assist the family by supplying invitations for this reception. Any program at the reception will be planned and presented by the family and/or friends.
